

# Plaited Cable Reversible Scarf (Chunky)



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# Plaited Cable Reversible Scarf

Specs: Finished length: 70" Width: 4"

Materials: US 13 / 9.0 mm Needles, Cable Needle

Yarn: Bernat Alpaca Natural Blends (bulky)

How much: 2 skeins = 240.0 yards (219.5m)

This scarf is worked completely in K1, P1, which is what makes the cable look exactly the same on both sides. Please remember to keep to this stitch pattern throughout, including your bind off.

Abbreviations:

K - Knit

P - Purl

C - Cable

F - Front

B- Back

C 20 F

1. slip 10 stitches purl wise to cable needle and hold to front of work.
2. Work next 10 stitches in K1, P1 pattern.
3. Work 10 stitches from cable needle in K1, P1 pattern.
4. Work remaining 10 stitches in K1, P1 pattern.

C 20 B

1. Work 10 stitches in K1, P1 pattern.
2. slip 10 stitches purl wise to cable needle and hold to back of work.
3. Work next 10 stitches in K1, P1 Pattern
4. Work 10 stitches from cable needle in K1, P1 pattern.



# Plaited Cable Reversible Scarf

*I wanted an "instant gratification project" that would keep my attention, be easy to remember and would make a lovely gift... This is it! I hope you find this scarf as enjoyable to knit as I have.*

*(Please remember that the entire scarf is worked in K1, P1)*



CO 30 sts.

## Pattern:

Rows 1-9: K1, P1 across, turn.

Row 10: C 20 F = (slip 10 sts. onto cable needle and hold to front of work) Keeping in pattern stitch; (K1, P1)work across next 10 st's. K1, P1 across 10 sts from cable needle, K1, P1 remaining 10 sts., turn.

Rows 11-19: K1, P1 across, turn.

Row 20: K1, P1 10 sts., C 20 B = ( slip 10 sts. onto cable needle and hold to back of work) Using K1, P1, work across next 10 sts. K1, P1 across 10 sts from cable needle. turn.

Continue in this pattern until you have 9 pattern repeats or until desired length, ending with K1, P1 across, for 9 rows. Bind off in pattern.
